01 Competitors will be divided into the following Levels:

02 Students of only **Intermediate and Senior Levels** are eligible to participate in **Recitation and Oratory** competitions in Odia, Hindi and English. For Oratory competitions, maximum 4 minutes shall be permitted to speak.

03 Participants of only **Intermediate and Senior Levels** are eligible to participate in **Essay Writing** competitions in **Odia, Hindi and English. Topics will be given on the spot.**

04 Topics for the Oratory Competitions will be displayed **at YMCA Office Notice Board or on the website of YMCA Cuttack ONE day before** commencement of the competitions and Recitations can be obtained from **YMCA Office or available on the website of YMCA Cuttack.**

05 Participants are not allowed to use books, any type of gadgets (mobile phones, smart watches, calculators, etc.) or notes during the time of any competition.

06 NATIONAL ANTHEM:

- (i) **One group of students below standard 1 AND/OR one group of students of standard 1 and above comprising of 5 to 9 number of students in each group from a school can participate.**
- (ii) Musical instruments and music tracks are not allowed.

07 PATRIOTIC SONG:

- (i) **One group of students below standard 1 AND/OR one group of students of standard 1 and above comprising of 5 to 9 number of students in each group from a school can participate.**
- (ii) Time limit is **FIVE to EIGHT MINUTES.**
- (iii) **MAXIMUM THREE MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS** are allowed to be used. **MUSIC TRACKS** are not allowed. **Musical Instrument players are not participants.**
- (iv) Three copies of the lyrics may be submitted at YMCA Office during the time of registration or at least **ONE DAY** before commencement of the competition by **6 p.m.**
- (v) Pre-recorded songs are **NOT** allowed.

08 SIT-N-DRAW:

- (i) Participants of all Levels are eligible to participate in Sit-n-Draw competition. No topics for Kindergarten, Beginner and Junior. Topics for Intermediate and Senior will be declared on spot.
- (ii) **What to bring:** Participants are requested to bring their own painting materials & boards. Drawing sheets will be provided by YMCA.

09 ENGLISH NURSERY RHYMES:

- (i) Only **ONE** group comprising of **FIVE to SEVEN** numbers of students of only **Kindergarten Level** from each school can participate.
- (ii) Time limit is **FIVE to EIGHT MINUTES.**
- (iii) **Musical Instruments** are not allowed.

10 ENGLISH HAND WRITING:

- (i) Participants of only **Beginner and Junior Level** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Participants are requested to bring their own Pencil, Eraser, Sharpener etc. Sample papers with cursive sentence will be provided by YMCA.

11 G. K. COMPETITION:

- (i) Participants of **Beginner, Junior, Intermediate and Senior Levels** are eligible to participate in this competition. Multiple choice questions will be given, so participants have to tick the correct answer.

12 SPELLING COMPETITION:

- (i) Participants of only **Kindergarten, Beginner and Junior Levels** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Participants are requested to bring their Pencil, Pen, Writing Board, Eraser, Sharpener, etc. Paper will be provided by YMCA.
- (iii) Participants have to write the words according to the dictation.

13 QUIPUZZ:

- (i) Participants of only **Junior, Intermediate and Senior Levels** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Question based hints will be given based on which puzzle has to be solved.
- (iii) Across and Down scenario will be given.

14 MEMORIZER:

- (i) Participants of only **Beginner, Junior, Intermediate and Senior Groups** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) List of items will be displayed in the white/black board with picture and spellings for **Five minutes**. Thereafter, Participants have to write the same with correct spellings.

15 TEST YOUR BRAIN:

- (i) Shapes, Sizes, Numerics, etc. will be given with choices of answer. Students just have to tick the correct answer by thinking logically.
- (ii) Example:



Which figure logically belongs on the spot of the question mark

16 CROSS WORD PUZZLE:

- (i) Picture or hints-based puzzle will be given.
- (ii) Participants have to fill the blank puzzle with correct answer & spelling.

17 JOIN THE DOTS AND COLOUR:

- (i) Participants of only **Kindergarten, Beginner and Junior Levels** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Serial numbers with dots will be given in a paper. Participants have to join the dots serially to complete the picture and then colour it.
- (iii) Participants can use any type of paint or colour.
- (iv) Drawing Sheet will be provided by YMCA to each participant.
- (v) Participants are requested to bring their own painting materials & drawing board.

18 WORD FORMATION:

- (i) Participants of only **Beginner, Junior, Intermediate and Senior Levels** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Letters will be given as shown in the example; students have to form meaningful words.
- (iii) Words can be formed Across (Left to Right or Right to Left), Down (Top to Bottom or Bottom to Top) & diagonally.

19 CREATIVE DRAWING & PAINTING:

- (i) Participants of only **Beginner, Junior, Intermediate and Senior Levels** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Topic will be declared on spot based on some theme.
- (iii) Participants have to draw and paint of their own imagination related to the topic.
- (iv) Participants are requested to bring their own painting materials & drawing board. Drawing sheet will be provided by YMCA.

20 ENGLISH EXTEMPORE:

- (i) Participants of **Intermediate and Senior Levels** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Separate topics will be kept in a box / bowl, participants have to pick one topic. Participants will be allowed **one minute** to think and **one minute** of speech in English relevant to the topic.

21 ENGLISH NURSERY RHYMES:

- (i) **School ID card** is mandatory for this event.
- (ii) Serial Number along with Gate Pass No will be displayed one day before the date of competition.
- (iii) Students will be permitted to enter the hall as per their serial number.
- (iv) In case a participant is absent while his/her serial number is called, then the participant has to wait until his/her serial number is called again.

22 MATH:

- (i) Participants of only **Beginner and Junior Levels** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Arithmetic problems are to be solved.

23 JUMBLED WORDS:

- (i) Participants of only **Junior, Intermediate and Senior Levels** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Letters in jumbled form will be given; participants have to form meaningful words and complete the worksheet as instructed.

24 PENCIL SHADING CONTEST:

- (i) Participants of only **Junior, Intermediate and Senior Levels** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Participants are requested to bring their own materials & drawing board. Drawing sheet will be provided by YMCA to each participant.
- (iii) Topic will be on own choice.
- (iv) Colours, Charcoal or any other materials except pencils, eraser, sharpener and masking tape are not allowed.

25 PICTURE COLOURING CONTEST:

- (i) Participants of only **Beginner, Junior, Intermediate and Senior Levels** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Participants are requested to bring their own painting materials & drawing board.
- (iii) Drawing sheet along with picture will be provided by YMCA to each participant.
- (iv) Participants can use any medium of colour of their choice.

26 STORY TELLING CONTEST:

- (i) Participants of only **Beginner and Junior Levels** are eligible to participate.
- (ii) Stories presented can be authentic, adapted or originally written.
- (iii) Stories presented must not touch on sensitive issues such as race, religion, stereotyping, politics, etc.
- (iv) Stories must be thematically educational.
- (v) Props may be used but backdrops and sound effects are not allowed.
- (vi) Time allocated to present the story in **English Language** shall be within 4 to 5 minutes.

For registration of all group / school-wise competitions, a forwarding letter on the letterhead of the School and undersigned by the School Authority is required, mentioning the name of the competition, names of students participating along with their respective classes, name and WhatsApp number of the teacher-in-charge, which is to be submitted at the office of YMCA Cuttack during registration along with the payment of the registration fee in cash/UPI, acknowledged with a registration-cum-money receipt. For registration of Patriotic Song / English Nursery Rhymes, the lyrics of the Song / Rhymes has to be submitted at the time of registration.

- ✓ Registration of any **group / school-wise competition closes at 6:00 p.m. the day before the date of competition**.
